

Dear Elementary Parents,

Below is a list of school supplies that your child will need for the upcoming school year. Please ensure that all materials are labeled with your child's name. The first day of school will be **TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 6th, 2022, from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Doors will be opened by 8:10 so your child can get ready for his/her day.** It is imperative that your child comes to school on time each day, as he/she will miss important morning activities and announcements. Also, don't forget to pack a lunch and snacks for the first day as it is a full school day (no nut products as we are a nut aware school).

Programming Reminders

- a) Every child may be given a numbered textbook (depending on subject area and grade level) for the year. Any book assigned to him/her will be expected to be handled with care. If for whatever reason, the book gets lost or damaged, it is the responsibility of the parent to replace the book for its FULL cost.
- b) Any consumable workbooks (such as Spelling Workout, Language Power etc.) that may get lost over the course of the school year will be the responsibility of the parent to purchase a new one.

Please label all items with a permanent marker.

- 1) 1 package of HB pencils or mechanical pencils (upper grades only) → ONLY 4 AT A TIME NEED TO BE BROUGHT TO SCHOOL
- 2) mechanical pencil refills (upper grades only) → if required
- 3) 1 package of pencil crayons (24 pack)
- 4) 1 package of fine lined markers
- 5) geometry set (upper grades only)
- 6) white-out (**not** in liquid form please; upper grades only)
- 7) erasable pens only (upper grades only)
- 8) ruler with metric measurement
- 9) Erasers
- 10) Knapsack and lunchbox
- 11) place mat (Please label with permanent marker)
- 12) Pencil case
- 13) Sharpener
- 14) Scissors
- 15) Glue stick → will need to be replenished throughout the school year
- 16) 2 pocket folders
- 17) **Re-usable** water bottle (labeled with permanent marker)
- 18) Change of clothes (1 set) Please label all clothing and ensure that they are appropriate to the season. Place clothing in a canvas gym bag (with a drawstring)
- 19) bug repellent and sunscreen (labeled)
- 20) 1 pair of indoor running shoes and one pair of outdoor running shoes. Please ensure all shoes are **non-marking**. Shoes need to be feasible for gym class as well.**
