As a part of MSK's commitment to keep parents informed of how their son/daughter is performing academically there is a policy whereby all tests, quizzes, and major assignments (with rubric) are sent home for parental perusal and discussion. These must be signed and returned to school the following day. This policy enforces ownership and responsibility on the student's behalf; and communication between parent(s) and their child regarding educational standards.

As the year progresses a variety of assignments may be sent home for completion or signing. This may include:

- tests
- key assessments/exit tickets
- quizzes
- term project
- culminating activity
- assignments

Children are encouraged to share their academic tasks, progress, and achievements with their parents on an ongoing basis.

Should you have any questions about your child's progress or if you are not receiving assessed work, please do not hesitate to call. In the absence of this communication, ***we will assume that you are fully aware of your son/daughter's academic progress.*** As always, if there are any major academic concerns, we will contact you immediately.
